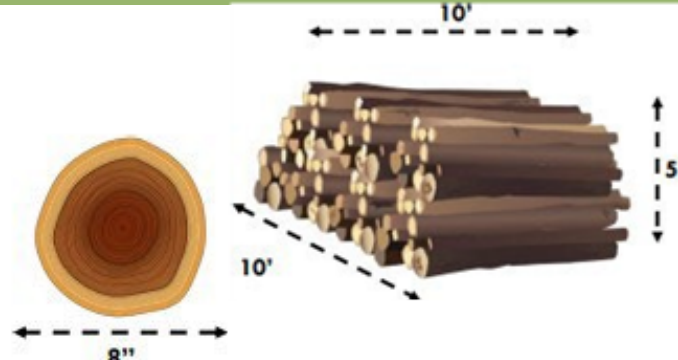
You cut, we chip!

Incorrect

✓ DO:

-  Clear defensible space of 100 ft around your house and 30ft around roads.
-  Face all cut ends in one direction, toward the road.
-  Make piles that are within 8ft of a road or driveway with good access.
-  Ensure that material to be chipped is less than 8in in diameter.
-  Make piles no more than 10ft wide, 10ft long and 5ft high.

✗ DON'T:

-  Include roots, stumps, rocks or mud in your piles.
-  Don't include poison oak, scotch or french broom that has gone to seed, acacia that has gone to seed, eucalyptus bark, palm fonds or blackberry vines.
-  Make piles of leaves, pine needles or grass trimmings (they can't be chipped).
-  Stack anything with non-vegetative materials such as trash, wire, or metal.

Protect your property from wildfire.
Create defensible space by maintaining the vegetation around your home.

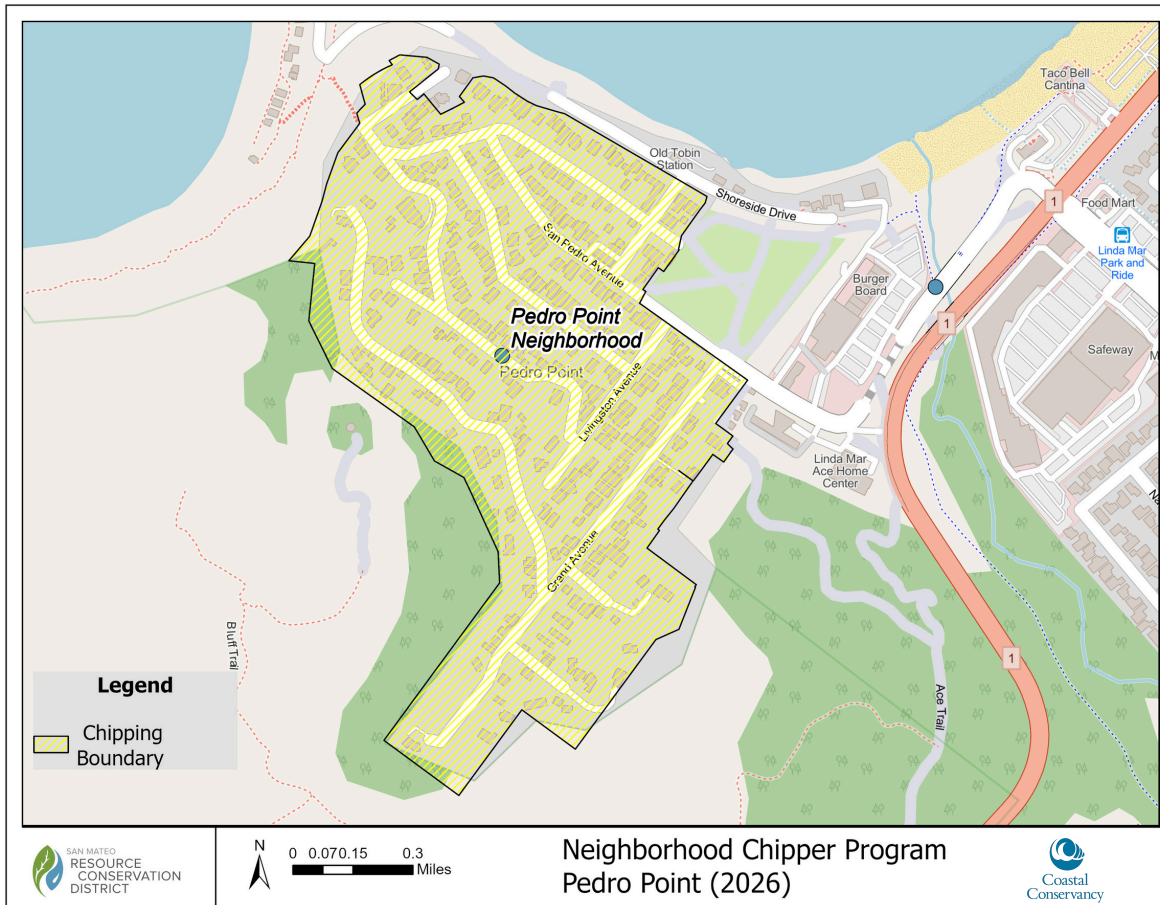
